ABOUT THE BOOTSTRAP SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Bootstrap is set up to offer financial assistance to Crook County young people who may not have been eligible for traditional scholarships. Your GPA is history and will not be considered as part of the award criteria. The future is what's important now.

If you are working while going to school, Bootstrap will match your earnings up to \$7,500 for each of two years.

- To be eligible, you must fit the following profile:
 - o Be between the ages of 18 and 24.
 - o Be a graduate of a high school, or equivalent, in Crook County.
 - Be attending or accepted into a school of higher education (college, university, trade/vocational school or program).
 - o Have a job and be working for someone other than a member of your family.

Your goal may be that of a dental assistant or a dentist. A welder or an engineer. A phlebotomist or a doctor. A truck driver or a fleet owner. Any advanced schooling should help you achieve your goal. Your willingness to pull on your own bootstraps to lift yourself to a better position in the future makes you an applicant.
